Sentence Writing Test

Directions: Write a sentence for the three words below. Sentences should help readers understand the actual meaning of the word. Sentences must also contain at least 7 words and not begin with the word "I."

Sentences will be scored from 0-8 points each with higher scores being given to sentences that help readers understand the meaning of the word. Higher scores also given to sentences that begin with nouns, verbs or the word "The." Students can also write the definition of the word if they would like instead. Combining the word and sentence scores allows for a maximum of 104 points.
